Chemical Use Policy

All Windells Academy members must read, understand, sign, and return this form:

Any use or possession of a controlled substance (I.e. Marijuana, Steroids, Cocaine, Meth Amphetamines, or the like), Alcohol, Tobacco, or Paraphernalia by a member of Windells Academy is grounds for expulsion from all Windells Academy activities without refund. Should Windells Academy determine, at their sole discretion, the offense and circumstances warrant a suspension plan the student's suspension will be designated as either "on campus" or "off campus". All additional fees for supervision and special programming are the responsibility of the student's parent or guardian. Following any suspension students will be required to be tested and checked weekly at their parent or guardian's expense. Failure to test negative or any secondary violation will result in expulsion with no refund. Included may also be a 21-day suspension from all USASA/USSA/FIS competitions, which is the maximum suspension, allowed without any additional appeal for longer suspension. Windells Academy may pursue a full six-month suspension from USASA/USSA/FIS in all instances of violation.

1. Above all, remember to always be respectful, kind and considerate of your classmates & roommates. Treat others as you wish to be treated. Requests for quiet or cleaning are not personal attacks, but simply requests.
2. Should maintenance problems arise with the dormitory facilities (e.g., light bulbs burning out, toilets backing up, etc.), alert your Life Coach and they will work with the staff to resolve the issue as quickly as possible.
3. It should go without saying, but drugs, violence, harassment, and other illegal activities will not be tolerated.
4. Fighting, unruly behavior, harassment of any kind including disturbing noise is NOT allowed.
5. Respect your roommates' belongings. Theft of any kind or possession of stolen property is strictly prohibited.
6. Student residents are responsible for keeping their rooms in a sanitary condition daily and must maintain an organized living environment.
7. Students must respect the curfew. "Sneaking out" after the curfew can lead to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion without refund.
8. Destruction of property is a serious offense and can lead to disciplinary action up to and including charges for repair and expulsion.

Anti-Bullying Policy

All Windells Academy members must read, understand, sign, and return this form:

Students must understand that bullying of any kind will not be tolerated and can lead to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion. Bullying is defined to be unwanted, aggressive behavior that involves a real or perceived power imbalance. The behavior is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated, over time. There are three main types of bullying:

Verbal Bullying (Saying or writing mean things):

- Teasing or name-calling
- Inappropriate sexual comments
- Taunting
- Threatening to cause harm

Social Bullying (Hurting someone's reputation or relationships):

- Excluding someone on purpose
- Cursing other students not to be friends with someone
- Spreading rumors about someone
- Embarrassing someone in public
- Using social media to attack, hurt, or embarrass

Physical Bullying (Hurting a persons body or possessions)

- Hitting/kicking/pinching
- Spitting
- Tripping/pushing

- Damaging a person’s belongings
- Making mean or rude hand gestures

CO-ED Policy

Expectations: If students of different genders would like to hang out in the same cabin the following rules must be followed:

1. There must be *at least* three people present (One-on-one will not be allowed)
2. Students may only visit during established visiting hours
3. All Life Coaches on duty must be notified via text or verbally
4. Students must get confirmation from staff first
5. Students may only be in the common areas of the cabin, such as the living room or kitchen. Bedrooms are PROHIBITED
6. All curtains must be open so that staff can easily see into the cabin

Visiting Hours: Visiting hours will be as follows. These hours may change in case of travel, double days or any unusual academy schedule.

Monday – Thursday, Sunday: 7:00PM – 10:00 PM
 Friday – Saturday: 7:00PM – 11:00PM

Consequences: In the event that any of the above rules are not followed or are broken, the following disciplinary action will be taken:

- 1st Offense – Student will receive a warning and will be required perform extra cleaning or work duties. Parents will be notified.

- 2nd Offense - Student will be on probation and lose visiting privileges for one week. They will be required to do kitchen dish duty or other hard work details for that week. Parents will be notified.
- 3rd Offense - Student will be on probation for the rest of the school semester and lose visiting privileges indefinitely. Student could face disciplinary action up to and including expulsion without refund.
